Researchers and writers use these products to locate bibliographic data and create bibliographies for manuscripts, grant proposals and other publications. It automates the creation of bibliographies, a tedious and error-prone activity when performed manually. Using these products, writers save time typing and interpreting style requirements of publications by simply selecting the publication by name and generating a perfectly formatted document. Endnote can also: Create an unlimited no. of databases, organise references and images, search databases on the internet, create instant bibliographies as you write in Word etc. A free 30 trial version of Endnote is available on www.endnote.com
